The following agenda items were discussed:

- 1. Minutes of NLC meeting of 8/18/09:** Read and accepted.
- 2. Communications:** none
- 3. East Haven Update:** Charlie attended a meeting in East Haven where concerns were expressed about speed around the new construction on Burr St. Some of the public expressed concerns about the traffic and safety issue.
- 4. New Haven Update:** Arlene said that officials are looking into the Burr St. traffic problem and also trying to rectify some construction issues. They are also considering looking into a stop sign.
- 5. Tweed New Haven Airport Update:** Diane reported that construction is nearing completion at the North end. As regards the above problems: The airport is willing to respond to such concerns and wants to be a good neighbor. Diane took names and phone numbers of those present.
- 6. Other:** Ron Suggested we go into public comments and took a list of attendees.
- 7. Public Comments:** All were concerned about a their safety because of the speed of traffic, the nature of their driveways fronting on the fast moving Burr St. Traffic and in some cases the lack of a safely engineered driveway apron to allow one to turn into the driveway without a near stop to make a right angle turn. In addition most complained about the broken pavement on Burr St. forcing cars to go over the center line..
  - a. Fico: Where is the East Haven/New Haven line now? His house is at the line. Arlene will look into putting up a sign.
  - b. Josephine – 384 Burr St. - Driveway not finished; no curbs; lawn scarred from construction. She had contacted Mike Piscatelli who was going to look into these problems.
  - c. Rosemary 330 Burr: Part of lawn dug up.
  - d. John 336 Burr. Almost got rear ended turning into his driveway. Can't get out of his driveway into traffic.
  - e. Brian and Lisa 366 Burr- Mainly concerned about the speed. Driveway is now on a poor angle for visibility and to get in and out safely- very dangerous. Also the parking space at the end of the driveway is now too narrow to safely park a car.
